PressReader Manual and Registration

1. 1. Requirements for the use of PressReader are:

- A valid SWITCH edu-ID.
No SWITCH edu-ID yet? Create a SWITCH edu-ID here: <https://eduid.ch/web/registration/1/?lang=en>
- A valid swisscovery card no.
No swisscovery card number yet? Create a swisscovery account here: <https://registration.slsp.ch/?lang=en>

2. The use of PressReader works via PURA / SLSKey.

The activation is done by Zentralbibliothek Zurich: <https://www.zb.uzh.ch/en> (see 3.)

3. 3. E-mail to kundenservice@zb.uzh.ch

- You will need your library card number, (see 1.) and a scan of your ID/passport.
After one year the access has to be renewed.

4. Wait for reply from kundenservice@zb.uzh.ch.

- [... We just have activated your access for PURA / SLSKey. Your login is now working ...]

5. Open PressReader in your browser and “register” under the following link:

(the language setting can be changed after logging in)

- PressReader can also be used on mobile devices – please install the PressReader App.
(login according to the browser login)

6. The renewal of the access after 7 days is done according to the instructions (see 7.)
