Thank you for your letter of September 29, inquiring about a possible grant to enable you to visit the United States with a program of films by European film-makers and to make contact with American film-makers.


I am sorry to tell you that there is no way in which The Rockefeller Foundation can assist you in this endeavor, since the Arts Program is limited to the United States and its citizens.

With reference to the grants made by the Foundation to American independent film-makers, we did make four such exploratory grants in 1966. However, since that time no program in this area has developed at the Foundation.

A copy of Gregory Markopoulos' letter on your behalf has been made for our files, and with the thought that you might want the original, I am returning it to you.

I regret that it is necessary to send this disappointing reply and can only hope that you are able to obtain the financial assistance you seek from another source.
